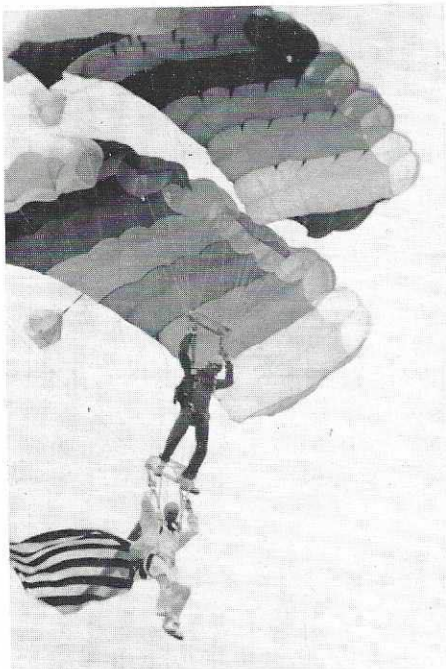

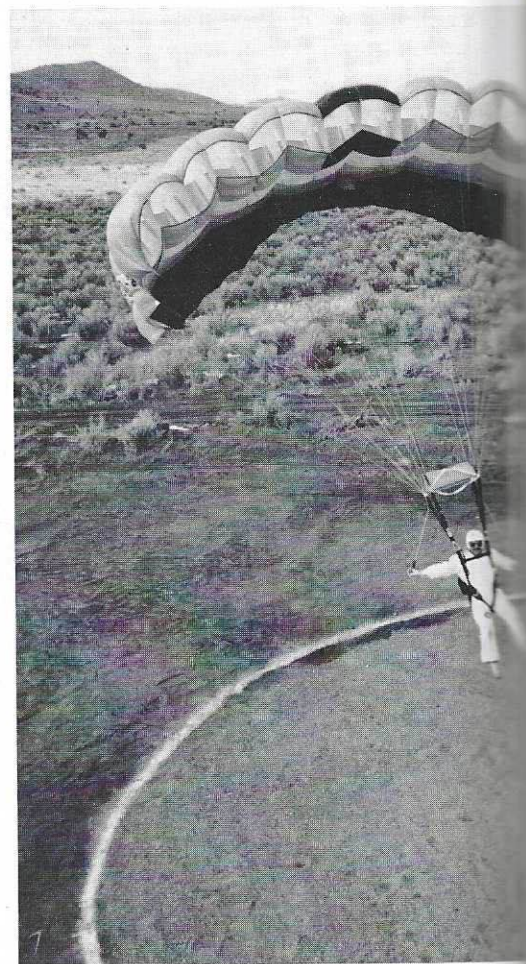
Allen Robinson gives the thumbs up while skydiving over Skydive DeLand, FL. Robinson is an Orlando based professional stuntman.
